Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 65-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 65-37 (COR) is an act to repeal Article 8 of Chapter 77, Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to removing the Guam Multi-Purpose Community Stadium Complex Commission. Section 2 of Public Law 26-119 states, “[a]ny board, commission, council or oversight body that has not met in the last twelve (12) months, with the exception of bodies relating to the Department of Education, the Guam Community College, the University of Guam, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, and the Guam Election Commission, shall hereby be abolished.”

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
