The Bureau requests that Bill No. 84-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 84-37 (LS) is an act to *add* a new subsection (c) to § 92111 of Article 1, Chapter 92, Title 9 of Guam Code Annotated, relative to requiring those convicted of vehicular homicide while impaired to support the surviving minor children of the victim.

Based on comments received from the Office of Attorney General regarding Bill No. 84-37(LS), the referenced Bill does not ascertain any immediate fiscal impact upon the revenues or the expenditure of any funds of the Government of Guam.
