 1/ The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) of Guam has reviewed Bill No. 111-37 (LS) and does not ascertain any immediate fiscal impact. Although the OAG had stated that there would be no immediate impact, the Bureau does anticipate that should Bill 111-37 (LS) be enacted, there could be operational costs incurred by the OAG and/or the Superior Court of Guam in terms of the enforcement of the Act should a civil action be commenced and continue through the legal system and/or judicial process. However, the Bureau is unable to provide an approximate fiscal impact at this time.
