The Bureau requests that Bill No. 12-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 12-37 (COR) is an act to amend § 60112 of Chapter 60, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to requiring prior approval from *I Liheslatura* before the Government of Guam, its various departments and agencies, including autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies purchase or enter into a lease, license, or sub-lease of property owned by the Federal government, foreign government, or sub entities thereof for a term in excess of five years.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
