The Bureau requests that Bill No. 13-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 13-37 (COR) is an act to amend § 83102(d) and add a new § 83116, to Chapter 83, all of Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to increasing public notice and transparency of the actions by the *Guam Twenty-First Century Healthcare Center Committee* responsible for the proposed medical healthcare campus. The proposed legislation intends to add members to the current composition of the Committee. Further, the legislation mandates all meetings of the Committee to be subject to the Open Government Law along with requirements to have all meeting minutes posted on the Guam Economic Development Authority website, that audio recordings of each meeting be provided to the Office of Public Accountability, and electronic copies of the meeting agendas, minutes, and other attachments and addendums as discussed in each meeting be provided to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
