1/ Per comments provided by the Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense (GHS/OCD) under the Office of the Governor of Guam, it is unable to ascertain any exact financial impacts to the extent the bill may impose should it become law. However, the GHS/OCD notes that although they currently have the capability of conducting virtual meetings, any additional assistive technology as mentioned under § 11104 of the proposed legislation would need to be acquired at a cost not known to the agency.
