Bureau of Budget and Management Research Comments on Bill No. 143-37 (LS)

The proposed legislation intends to require the availability of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in all Government of Guam departments/agencies, inclusive of autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies by June 30, 2024. It is noted that the intent is for each department/agency to provide access to an AED within an office that provides a service to the general community of Guam and have it be available during hours that the government offices are open to the public. Further, the Bill states that each department or agency may create the provisions for the deployment and use of AEDs.

The Bureau estimates that it will cost from \$143,000 to \$325,000 for the Government of Guam to make available an AED to each department/agency, including forty-two (42) Guam Department of Education school campuses, four (4) Guam charter school campuses, and nineteen (19) village mayors offices. The cost estimate provided could potentially increase as much as \$247,000 to \$429,000 if certain required AED accessories (see cost estimate – footnote 3/ below) are included with each purchase of the AED. Cost estimates will likely increase should each Government of Guam department/agency have more than one office. Lastly, there is no appropriation or funding source identified in the proposed legislation, and the estimated costs for the procurement of AEDs are not factored into the departments' FY 2024 certified budgets.
