 1/ As cited by the sponsors, the intent of the subject legislation is to provide immediate and effective relief to homes and businesses relative to power restoration after damages caused by natural disasters, including tropical depressions, typhoons and earthquakes. It should be noted that costs resulting from the adoption of the proposed legislation would not have an impact on appropriations to the Government of Guam but may potentially impact GPA ratepayers should additional personnel be required to conduct post-natural disaster inspections. However, the overall cost impact cannot be provided as GPA did not provide fiscal comments at the time this fiscal note was prepared.
