 1/ As cited by the sponsor, the intent of the subject legislation is to authorize the Guam Power Authority (GPA), with the consent of the Guam Public Utilities Commission (PUC), to procure a vendor to provide, install, and operate approximately forty (40) MW temporary power generation unit to be situated at the Cabras power plant in Piti, Guam. In its current form, the Bill is administrative in nature and would not have an impact on appropriations to the Government of Guam. However, there may be a cost impact to GPA ratepayers should the Guam PUC authorize GPA to proceed with the procurement outlined in the legislation. However, the overall cost impact cannot be provided as GPA did not provide fiscal comments at the time this fiscal note was prepared.
