The proposed legislation intends to amend §40101 of Chapter 40, Division 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to abolish the position of the Vice Mayor of Sinajana. Enactment of this legislation will change the total of vice mayors to a total of six (6).
Per correspondence with the Mayors' Council of Guam (MCOG) indicates that by abolishing the post of the Sinajana Vice Mayor, the MCOG and the Government of Guam will no longer need to provide an estimated total of \$94,521.40 for this position. Further, the MCOG does not anticipate any other financial impacts relative to the proposed legislation. It should be noted that the Bureau concurs with the estimated savings provided by the MCOG.
