Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 27-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 27-37 is an act to *add* a new Subsection (m) to Section 8501 and to amend § 8503(c) to Article 5, Chapter 8 of Title 4 Guam Code Annotated relative to the retirement of public safety and law enforcement officers who are members of the Defined Benefit 1.75 Retirement System.

The proposed amendments define which public safety and law enforcement officers qualify for the associated benefits as well as limits those who qualify at the Office of the Attorney General and the Department of Revenue and Taxation to Inspectors and Investigators.

Based on the foregoing, provisions in the subject legislation are administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact Government of Guam appropriations in FY 2023.
