1/ The Bureau notes that the adoption and implementation of the new proposed fee schedule (Exhibit A) for interventional radiology, respiratory, intensive care, surgery, recovery, laboratory, pharmacy, and special services will pose a positive fiscal impact on the revenue generation of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) to meet its financial obligations, operating expenses, and capital improvement needs. Per comments from the GMHA, the estimated net fiscal impact is \$0.4M in revenues comprised of \$3.4M in gross revenues and \$3M in costs to purchase new supplies and medicine.

**AN ACT TO ADOPT THE 51 NEW HOSPITAL FEES
PROPOSED BY THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL
AUTHORITY AND RECEIVED BY I MINA' TRENTAI
SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN ON APRIL 11,
2024**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority
4 (GMHA) submitted a fee package to the Guam Legislature on April 11, 2024,
5 containing a total of fifty-one (51) new fees compromised of the following hospital
6 departments: Interventional Radiology, Special Services, Laboratory, Intensive Care
7 Unit, Operating room (Surgery & Recovery), and Respiratory and Pharmacy. The
8 GMHA fee package submission is appended to this Act and identified as "Exhibit
9 A".

10 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in accordance with 10 GCA, §80109,
11 the GMHA has the power to establish "a schedule of fees" to be charged by the
12 Hospital that shall be sufficient to recover the operating costs and fixed costs and to
13 generate such revenue as is necessary to enable the Hospital to meet its financial
14 obligations, operating expenses and capital improvement needs. Pursuant to this

1 section, the GMHA shall also conduct public hearings for any new fee or rate
2 increase more than five percent (5%). The GMHA conducted a public hearing on
3 March 19, 2024, but no public discussion occurred during this junction.

4 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority
5 (GMHA) Board of Trustees subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-27 on March
6 27th, 2024 “Relative to Approving New Fees and Existing Fee Schedule” including
7 the fifty-one (51) new fees and a total of 10,086 existing Hospital facility fees which
8 have been previously “adjudicated by the Legislature”. Considering the potential
9 economic impact of this proposed fee package, it is necessary to provide a forum for
10 public discourse and stakeholder engagement on this matter.

11 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ascertain that the people
12 of Guåhan are afforded ample opportunity to fully review and comment on the
13 proposed fees by adopting the fee package and subsequently conducting a public
14 hearing that will provide an opportunity for citizens and other stakeholders to discuss
15 these fees further.

16 **Section 2. Adoption of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority’s Fee**
17 **Schedule.**

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, *I Mina’ Trentai Siette Na*
19 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby adopts the fee schedule transmitted by the Guam
20 Memorial Hospital on April 11, 2024, subject to revisions based on public testimony
21 and recommendations received during the Guam Legislature’s public hearing
22 process and appended to this Act as “Exhibit A”.

23 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall become immediately effective
24 upon enactment.

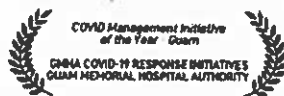

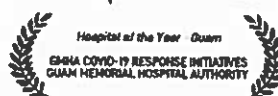

WHEREAS, Public Law 26-66, places the rate making authority of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority under the GMHA Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 29-02 requires all government departments and agencies to conduct an annual public hearing prior to April 1 on existing fee schedules and shall regularly adjust existing fees;

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees has reviewed the Public Law 26-66 and Public Law 29-02; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on March 19, 2024 and oral comments and written testimony have been solicited regarding the fifty-one (51) new fees comprised of the following Hospital departments: Interventional Radiology, Special Services, Laboratory, Intensive Care Unit, Operating Room (Surgery & Recovery), Respiratory and Pharmacy; and

WHEREAS, a total of 10,086 existing Hospital facility fees were also presented at the public hearing, which fees were already adjudicated by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees has reviewed the list of new fees and found the same to be in order; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the GMHA Board of Trustees directs the Hospital Administrator/CEO to continue to proceed with the adjudication process of these 51 new fee items, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairperson certifies and the Secretary attests to the adoption of this resolution.

Ms. Hechanova also cited the enactment of Public Law 26-66 in December 2001, which removed the rate-setting jurisdiction from the PUC and gave it to the GMHA Board of Trustees and the Guam Code Annotated 10GCA §80109 that gave the authority to the Hospital to set its rates. In compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law and further Guam Code Annotated directives, the Hospital published in the Guam Daily Post the announcement of this public hearing. The Hospital also posted the announcement of this public hearing on the GovGuam Public Notices Portal to notify the public. The Hospital also sent the notice of this public hearing via facsimiles to various news media organizations and via electronic mail to the Governor's Office, Lieutenant Governor's Office, the Congressman's Office, and to our elected Senators of the 37 th Guam Legislature. In addition, letters were sent to the third party payers via electronic mail inviting them to join this public hearing via Zoom Video Conferencing.		Informational
