**BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH
COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 347-37 (LS)**

The proposed legislation intends to appropriate Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) from the Fiscal Year 2024 General Fund revenues collected in excess of the adopted levels enumerated in P.L. 37-42, as amended, to the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) for the purchase of Opioid Antagonists.

Per the August 2024 Consolidated Revenue and Expenditure Report (CRER), the projected net unobligated FY 2024 General Fund Revenue amounts to \$37,939,128. The Bureau notes that there are several competing legislative measures seeking to utilize the FY 2024 General Fund net unobligated revenues as shown in the table below. The subtotal of these competing measures amounts to \$108,995,660, or \$71,056,532 more than the cited projected unobligated General Fund revenues for FY 2024.
