The Bureau requests that Bill No. 37-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 37-37 is an act to name Public Law 36-130 the "Senator Jose 'Pedo' Terlaje Retirement Act."

The proposed amendment is to name the aforementioned public law in honor of the late Senator Terlaje who was instrumental in the passage of Bill No. 346-36 (COR) to what is now P.L. 36-130.

Based on the foregoing, the subject legislation is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact Government of Guam appropriations in FY 2023.
