The Bureau requests that Bill No. 40-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 40-37 (COR) is an act to add a new 3104.1 of Chapter 3 of Title 27 Guam Administrative Rules and Regulation and a new § 51104.01 of Chapter 51 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated relative to establishing a Moratorium on the Pre-employment Requirements as a Correctional Officer of the Department of Corrections.

The intent of the temporary moratorium on the pre-employment requirements for correctional officers is to enable the Department of Corrections to streamline and expedite their recruitment process to meet their needs. According to the DOC, the proposed legislation will not have a negative fiscal impact on the Department.

The Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
