The Bureau requests that Bill No. 49-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 49-37 (COR) is an act to *add* a new §67.401.1(a)(3) and *amend* §67.407 both of Chapter 67, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, regarding the possession etc. for illegal delivery, dispensing or manufacturing a controlled substance, and distribution to persons under age eighteen (18), and to persons suffering from a mental illness, disease or defect, or to pregnant persons.

Based on comments received from the Office of Attorney General regarding Bill No. 49-37, the referenced Bill does not ascertain any immediate fiscal impact upon the revenues or the expenditure of any funds of the Government of Guam.
