The Bureau requests that Bill No. 53-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 53-37 (COR) is an act to add new subsection (a)(9) to § 51111 of Article 1, Chapter 51, Division 2, Title 10, Guam Code annotated, relative to protecting Guam from the toxic exposure due to open detonation of hazardous waste.

The Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill 53-37 (COR) from the Guam Environmental Protection Agency and have not received any official comments as of the date of this fiscal note waiver. However, the bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
