Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 54-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 54-37 is an act to amend Article 1 of Chapter 63, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated (GCA), § 60107 of Chapter 60, Title 5, GCA, and § 12308 of Chapter 12 of Article 3, Division 2, Title 9 of the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations (G.A.R.R.) relative to game and fish regulations, protecting our marine preserves and standardizing penalties for violations of game and fish statutes and the adjudication process thereof. The Bill revises specific sections of Chapter 63, Title 5, GCA whereas "unlawful" acts are clarified as either a "misdemeanor" or "felony". Violations that are not identified as a misdemeanor or felony shall be adjudicated by the Traffic Court Division of the Superior Court of Guam. The Bill further amends violations and penalties of Chapter 60 & 63 of the GCA, as well as the rules and regulations in the G.A.R.R. specific to the harvesting of other marine invertebrates.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
