BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH
COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 8-37 (COR)

The proposed legislation is an act to add a new §5221 to Subarticle B of Article 3 to Chapter 5 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated to ensure the online accessibility and timely posting of any and all Government of Guam Invitations for Bids (IFBs) and Requests for Proposals (RFPs) on a dedicated Government website. The proposed legislation intends to mandate the Office of Technology to create and add official web pages and sections dedicated to any and all IFBs and RFPs on the website <https://notices.guam.gov>, or a separate website dedicated to announcing all IFBs and RFPs, with timely updates and maintenance of said announcement pages.

Upon enactment of Bill No. 8-37 (COR), the Bureau anticipates that OTECH must arrange a contract with their current vendor to add on a specific page reserved for IFBs and RFPs only. After reaching out to OTECH for comments regarding Bill No. 8-37 (COR), it was conveyed that it is possible to add an additional page to <https://notices.guam.gov>. Currently, OTECH expends approximately \$3,000.00 annually for the maintenance of this site. To implement this amendment, it is estimated that an additional \$2,000.00 will be required to add a web page specifically for IFBs and RFPs for the first year. It is anticipated that the OTECH will have to absorb the additional cost as there is no appropriation contained in Bill 8-37.
