Bill No. 1-37 (COR) - AN ACT TO AMEND § 24105 OF CHAPTER 24, TITLE 11 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO EXCLUDING THE VALUE ADDED TO BUILDINGS FROM THE INSTALLATION OF PHOTOVOLTAIC SOLAR PANELS AND ROOF TILES FOR PURPOSES OF LEVYING REAL ESTATE TAXES.

Bill No. 2-37 (COR) - AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 8B TO TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO IMPLEMENTING THE “SUPPLEMENTAL COLA ADJUSTMENT ACT,” A SUPPLEMENTARY COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT (COLA) FOR GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREES WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF GUAM, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 13108A TO CHAPTER 13, TITLE 2 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CREATING A SPECIAL COST OF LIVING ECONOMIC SERVICE.

Bill No. 3-37 (COR) - AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 34-116 §26202 OF CHAPTER 26, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO REDUCING THE BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAX FROM FIVE PERCENT (5%) TO FOUR PERCENT (4%). ALL LIMITED EXEMPTIONS ON THE BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAX IN §26203.2 OF CHAPTER 26 TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED REMAIN IN EFFECT AND ARE NOT CHANGED BY THIS ACT.

Bill No. 4-37 (COR) - AN ACT TO TEMPORARILY SUSPEND THE BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAX ON FOOD AND MEDICINE, FOR TWELVE (12) CONSECUTIVE MONTHS.
