

Re: Funding Availability Note: Bill No. 325-37 (COR)

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Hafa Adai Senator San Agustin!

Pursuant to the Standing Rules of the 37th Guam Legislature, the Committee on Appropriations and/or the Office of Finance and Budget (OFB) shall determine in writing if the funding source cited in Appropriation or Authorization for Appropriations bills are sufficient.

The Office has received Bill No. 325-37 (COR), AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION TO LEASE ALL OR A PORTION OF LOT NO. 7161-R1 IN YIGO, GUAM TO THE GUAM MOTORSPORTS ASSOCIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FAMILIES WITH A SAFE AND REGULATED SPACE FOR DRAG RACING AND OTHER ON AND OFF-ROAD MOTOR RACING, MOTORBIKING, AND CAR SHOWS AND ACTIVITIES, AND TO FURTHER APPROPRIATE THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLEANING AND PREPARING LOT NO. 7161-R1 IN YIGO, FOR PUBLIC USE.

The proposed Bill No. 325-37 (COR) appropriates Three Hundred Dollars (\$300,000) from FY 2024 General Fund revenues collected in excess of the adopted levels enumerated in Public Law 37-42, as amended, to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission for the purpose of cleaning and preparing Lot No. 7161-R1 in Yigo, Guam for public use.

Based on the Bureau of Budget and Management Resource's Consolidated Revenue and Expenditure Report (CRER) as of June 30, 2024, the unobligated projected FY 2024 General Fund Revenue is \$36,472,524. However, it should be noted that there are other competing legislative measures utilizing revenues collected in excess of the adopted FY 2024 General Fund level: 1) Bill No. 221-37 (\$350,000), 2) Bill No. 225-37 (\$5,000,000), 3) Bill No. 231-37 (\$1,500,000), 4) Bill No. 251-37 (\$11,300,000), 5) Bill No. 264-37 (\$5,000,000), 6) Bill No. 284-37 (\$966,925), 7) Bill No. 296-37 (\$1,563,601.50), 8) Bill No. 304-37 (5,000,000), 9) Bill No. 308-37 (\$7,823,735), 10) Bill No. 309-37 (\$1,000,000), 11) Bill No. 315-37 (\$9,000,000), 12) Bill No. 316-37 (\$50,000), 13) Bill No. 318-37 (\$400,000), 14) Bill No. 321-27 (\$7,000,000), 15) Bill No. 322-37 (\$15,000,000), 16) Bill No. 324-37 (\$510,000) and 17) Bill No. 325-37 (\$300,000). These bills, including the subject bill, amount to \$71,764,262. Therefore, the funding availability is dependent upon which measures are enacted as the unobligated balance is insufficient to cover all measures as of the June 2024 CRER.
