AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (f) TO § 80.37 OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 80, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE POSSESSION OR USE OF AN EXPLOSIVE OR AN IMPROVISED EXPLOSIVE DEVICE IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1.** A new Subsection (f) is *added* to § 80.37 of Article 2, Chapter
- 3 80, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
- 4 "(f) Whoever possesses or uses an explosive device as defined in 10 GCA,
- 5 Chapter 61, § 61100, or an improvised explosive device (defined as those devices

- 1 that are placed or fabricated in an improvised manner incorporating destructive,
- 2 lethal, noxious, pyrotechnic, or incendiary chemicals and designed to destroy,
- 3 incapacitate, harass, or distract, which may incorporate military weapons, but are
- 4 normally devised from non-military components) in the commission of a felony
- 5 punishable under the laws of Guam shall, in addition to the punishment imposed for
- 6 the commission of such felony, be imprisoned for a term of not less than ten (10)
- 7 years nor more than twenty-five (25) years."
- 8 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- 9 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
- affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
- 11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 12 severable.
- 13 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
