**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 8103(e) TO CHAPTER 8 OF
TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS MEETING
AUDIO AND/OR VIDEO FILES TO BE POSTED ON THE
RESPECTIVE AGENCY'S WEBSITE WITH A LINK TO
THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY'S
WEBSITE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that to better observe the performance of public officials in their deliberation and
4 decision-making process to craft public policy, the meeting audio and/or video files
5 should also be posted on the respective agency's website.

6 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to further increase the public's
7 access to information on government meetings, deliberations, and decision-making

1 by requiring boards and commissions meeting audio and/or video files to be posted
2 on the respective agency’s website with a link to the Office of Public
3 Accountability’s website.

4 **Section 2.** A new Subsection (e) is hereby *added* to § 8103 of Chapter 8,
5 Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

6 “(e) All audio and/or video files, if applicable, of board and commission
7 meetings or a link to said files shall be posted on the respective agency’s website. A
8 link to the Office of Public Accountability’s website shall also be available on each
9 agency’s website. The Office of Public Accountability shall post the audio and/or
10 video files of all board and commission meetings or a link to said files on the OPA’s
11 website.”
