



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 3102 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3,
TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
CREATING EIGHT (8)-YEAR DRIVER'S LICENSES
THAT ALIGNS WITH THE MAXIMUM RENEWAL
PERIOD ALLOWED UNDER THE REAL ID ACT.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
3 recognizes that extending the validity of driver's licenses issued by the Department
4 of Revenue and Taxation (DRT) from three (3) years to eight (8) years is a significant
5 step towards improving the efficiency and convenience of Guam's driver's licensing
6 system. This extension aligns with the maximum period authorized under the REAL
7 ID Act, a federal law that was enacted to enhance the security and integrity of

1 identification documents used for various purposes, including air travel and access
2 to federal facilities. By synchronizing Guam’s driver’s license expiration period with
3 the REAL ID Act, *I Liheslatura* aims to add an eight (8)-year driver’s license to the
4 existing license terms for our residents, and bring substantial benefits to both drivers
5 and the DRT because it will result in shorter lines for renewals.

6 **Section 2.** § 3102 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated,
7 is hereby *amended* to read:

8 **“§ 3102. Same: Fees.**

9 The following fee schedule in Subsections (a) through (h) is valid for a
10 three (3) year period. The applicant may elect for an operator’s license,
11 notwithstanding § 3101(m) of this Article, which shall be valid for a five (5)-
12 year period or for an eight (8)-year period; provided, that the fee for such a
13 license shall be Forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) for a five (5)-year license and
14 Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00) for an eight (8)-year license. The fee for the
15 issuance of a motor vehicle driver’s license is as follows:

18 An instruction permit shall not be issued for a period to exceed ninety
19 (90) days. A temporary permit shall not be issued for a period to exceed thirty
20 (30) days.”

21 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

22 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
23 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
24 affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without
25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
26 severable.
