## AN ACT ADD A *NEW* § 3410 TO CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 16 OF THE GUAM CODE; RELATIVE TO CURBSTONING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:p** 

Section 1. A new § 3410 is hereby *added* to Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam
Code Annotated to read:

## "§ 3410. Curbstoning; permit required.

(a) It *shall* be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on
public or private property having displayed thereon any writing indicating
that such vehicle is for sale without having a permit from the Guam Police
Department authorizing the sale of vehicles at that location.

9 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any one of the 10 following:

(1) A vehicle parked on private property having a permit from
the Guam Police Department authorizing the sale of vehicles at that
location;

(2) A single vehicle legally parked on the premises of, or in the
right-of-way immediately adjacent to a residence provided the vehicle
is owned by or registered to the occupant of the residence;

17 (3) A vehicle that is parked on either public or private property
18 adjacent to a building or location to which the vehicle owner has

- traveled to perform his normal course of business or employment or
   on a personal errand; *or*

(4) A vehicle that is parked on the premises of a bonafide auto dealer.

5 (c) The Chief of Police in consultation with the Director of Revenue 6 and Taxation, the Director of the Department of Public Works, and the 7 Director of the Department of Land Management, *shall* promulgate rules and 8 regulations which shall include but not be limited to reasonable fines and 9 fees to enforce this Section. Such rules shall be subject to the Administrative 10 Adjudication Law.

(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of § 9502 of Chapter 9.5 of Title 7
Guam Code Annotated, all fees and fines collected under this Section shall
be deposited into the Police Services Fund and made available by
appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

(e) This Section shall take effect upon the promulgation rules of
regulations enforcing this Section."
