ACT TO ESTABLISH THE **OFFICE OF** VITAL STATISTICS REVOLVING FUND, BY AMENDING §3227 OF CHAPTER 3, AND ADDING A NEW §3227.1 TO CHAPTER 3, OF ARTICLE 2, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent: I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds

that the Office of Vital Statistics under the Department of Public Health and Social

Services is currently responsible for issuing birth, marriage, and death certificates.

I Liheslaturan also finds that the funds generated from the services provided by the 5

Office of Vital Statistics are deposited into the General Fund of the government of

Guam. The Department of Public Health and Social Services is unable to realize 7

the benefits of any of the money collected for their services which are required to 8

9 fund the costs of operations.

I Liheslaturan finds that the Office of Vital Statistics is underfunded and 10

understaffed. Members of the staff who have retired from the Office of Vital

Statistics have not been replaced over the years, and currently, it is staffed by only

the territorial registrar and two (2) vital statistics clerks who serve the needs of the

entire population of Guam.

I Liheslaturan also finds that the Office of Vital Statistics is burdened with

using an antiquated computer system to manage their files. The staff currently

hand count records to retrieve data causing the staff to become frustrated and overworked and the process to obtain these certificates unnecessarily long.

It is the intent of this Bill to allow the fees generated by the Office of Vital Statistics to remain with this vital program, and to authorize that the funds shall be utilized by the Office of Vital Statistics to support and enhance its programs. This is accomplished by creating an Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund. This revolving fund shall fund additional staff for the office, and make possible the ability to upgrade to a fully automated computer system, as well as ensure the continued maintenance of this system. This will facilitate a more efficient service, with the critically needed ability to accommodate more clients on a timely basis.

**Section 2.** §3227 of Chapter 3, Article 2, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:

## "§ 3227. Fees for Copies.

- (a) The Director shall, by regulation, establish fees for certified copies of certificates or records issued; for the search of the files or records when no copy or information is available; for processing a change of name by court order and other means; for amending records; and for filing a delayed certificate of birth or marriage.
- (b) Fees collected under this section by the Office of Vital Statistics shall be deposited in the Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund, for expenditure as provided pursuant to §3227.1 of this Chapter [General Fund of the government of Guam according to procedures established by law governing collections]."
- Section 3. A new §3227.1 is hereby added to Chapter 3, Article 2, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

## "§3227.1. Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund.

- (a) Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund. There is hereby established a 2 Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund (Fund) to be maintained by the 3 Administrator, Office of Vital Statistics, of the Department of Public Health & 4 Social Services. The Fund shall be established and maintained in a bank account 5 apart and separate from the General Fund or any other bank account(s) of the 6 government of Guam, and shall not be co-mingled with, or a part of, the General 7 All funds due or accruing to the account from whatever source(s), as 8 provided or authorized pursuant to applicable law, inclusive of any interest, shall 9 be deposited in the Fund in its entirety immediately upon receipt by the 10 government of Guam. The Fund shall not be subject to the transfer authority of I 11 Maga'lahan Guåhan. It is further, provided, that: 12
  - (1) The Administrator of the Office of Vital Statistics, of the Department of Public Health & Social Services, *shall* report monthly and maintain full compliance with all financial reporting requirements of the government of Guam pursuant to applicable law; and
- 17 (2) Any and all collections deposited into and/or expenditures from the Fund *shall* be reported to *I Maga'lahan Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.
  - (b) Independent Records and Accounts. The Fund shall be maintained separate and apart from all other government funds; have an independent records and accounts concerning the Fund; and audited by the Public Internal Auditor or the Department of Interior for each fiscal year and shall provide *I Maga'lahan*

- Guåhan and the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan with a copy of the audited 1 2 report.
- (c) Deposits. All monies collected for products and services rendered by 3 the Office of Vital Statistics shall be accounted for and deposited into the Fund and 4 shall be available to pay for the expenses of the Office of Vital Statistics. 5
- 6 (d) Application. All monies deposited in the Fund shall be available to be used to pay for the expenses of the Office of Vital Statistics. The Fund may also 7 be used for the following expenses: 8
- (1) payment(s) for contractual services; 9
- (2) payment(s) for supplies; 10
- (3) payment(s) for any other expenses, which if remains unpaid may result 11 in an emergency situation as approved by the Director; and 12
- (4) Personnel. 13

- The Director shall submit an annual spending plan for the Fund in 14 accordance with and at the same time as the Bureau of Budget and Management 15 Research budget call. 16
- The Administrator of the Office of Vital Statistics, via the Director, 17 shall, by no later than the 20th day of each month, submit a financial report 18 relative to the status and activities of the Fund. The monthly report shall be submitted, via the Office of I Maga'lahan Guåhan, to the Speaker of I 20 Liheslaturan Guåhan, and the Chairpersons of the Committee on Finance, and the 21

- 1 Committee on Health of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. The report shall, at a minimum,
- 2 contain:

- 3 (1) all expenditures and encumbrances (monthly and year to date);
- 4 (2) funds received and source(s);
- 5 (3) status of accounts receivable for outstanding debts and/or delinquent 6 payment obligations owed to the Community Health Center(s); and
- 7 (4) any and all other pertinent information relative to the Fund.
- g) The Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund *shall* be included in the government of Guam annual audit review and report."
  - Section 4. Review and Adoption of Updated Fee Schedule. Within 120 days of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Department of Public Health & Social Services, in conjunction with the Office of Vital Statistics, shall review and amend the fee schedules of the Office of Vital Statistics, as needed, so as to provide for fee schedules realistically reflective of the cost of doing business; and as provided pursuant to Article 3 [Rule-Making Procedures], Chapter 9 [Administrative Adjudication Law], Division 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated [Government Operations].
  - **Section 5. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

- Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective
- 2 upon enactment.
