

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 1105 OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE 2, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO TERM LIMITS FOR SENATORS OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1105 of Chapter 1, Title 2, Guam Code Annotated is repealed and re-enacted to read:

"§ 1105. Senators, Terms of.

- (a) Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall hold office for a term of four (4) years and until their successors are elected and qualified. The term of Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall commence on the first Monday of January following the date of election.
- (b) Commencing on the general election of 2014, no person who has been elected to serve two (2) full successive four(4) year terms as Senator *shall* again be eligible to hold that office until one (1) full term has intervened."
