Comments on Bill No. 25-32 (COR)

The bill is seeking to reprogram available funds in the aggregate sum of \$1,112,167.25 to fund costs for certain capital improvement projects, heavy equipment needs, and flood mitigation purposes.

The original intent of the bond funding was to address pot hole repair and village streets, which are the responsibility of the Department of Public Works (DPW), separate from routed road highway related projects which are funded under the Federal highway program. Based on Section 2 of the bill, which appears as intended for DPW, a reprogramming of available bond funds will go toward specified village repairs under Item Nos. 1 (flood mitigation, Taitano Street, Harmon); 2 (flood mitigation residential unit, Barrigada); 4 (flood mitigation at access road, Dededo village); and 6 (flood mitigation, Yigo village). Funds are also being identifed for other flood mitigation purposes under Item Nos. 3 (purchase of excavator); 5 (purchase of backhoe); and 7 (for various DPW flood mitigation work island-wide (unspecified village locations).

Section 3 stipulates that prior to use of funds for purposes identified Section 2, DPW and the Department of Administration must certify that the capital projects initially authorized under the bond funds are completed. Additionally, information from the Guam Economic Development Authority Bond Counsel, reflects that "Because the 2001 bonds are fully paid, the Indenture no longer governs the funds..."

It is noted that the 2009 Village Streets Master Plan (VSMP) was developed to assist the Government of Guam by establishing baseline for needed improvements on the roadways that connect to the federally funded routed road network. However, per the DPW Acting Highway Administrator, amounts identified under the proposed legislation for the villages may not necessarily be related to projects under the VSMP.

The Yigo Mayor identified possible allocation of \$150,000 under Item No. 6 of Section 2 for flood mitigation (ponding basin) Marianas Terrace/ Chalan Goro Elena (VSMP list) / East Gayinero (VSMP list).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent: I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the projects funded and authorized pursuant to the Highway 2001 Bond 3 4 Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, and the Highway 1985 Bond Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA, 5 have been completed and that there are remaining funds available for 6 7 reprogramming for flood mitigation projects throughout the island. There are specific areas in Barrigada, Dededo and Harmon that require immediate action. 8 The projects listed in Section 2 of this Act are areas that the Department of Public 9 Works have been made aware of their conditions and the work necessary to 10 mitigate flooding. I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the acquisition of 11 heavy equipment for drainage improvement and emergency flood mitigation are 12 necessary tools for the Department of Public Works to carry out its mandates and 13 responsibilities to ensure proper maintenance of our roadways. 14

Reprogramming and Appropriation of Available Bond Section 2. 1 Funds. Section 3. The actual expenditure of funds reprogrammed and appropriated 17 pursuant to Section 2, shall only be made available for the projects approved 18 pursuant to this Act after the Department of Public Works and the Department of 19 Administration have certified that the capital projects initially authorized prior to 20 this Act have been completed. If additional funding is required for any projects 21 not yet competed, then, funding shall be subtracted, starting from the last project 22 prioritized in Section 2 of this Act, and so forth, until the original projects 23 authorized and funded pursuant to the initial purpose of the Bonds are completed. 24

Section 4. Reporting Requirement. The Department of Public Works and
 the Department of Administration shall submit a status report on all capital projects

initially authorized prior to this Act, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA and
§22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, as well as the status of capital projects and other
purposes authorized pursuant to this Act, to *I Maga'lahan Guåhan*, and the *Speaker, I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

5 Section 5. Severability. *If* any provision of this Act or its application to 6 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such 7 invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be 8 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the 9 provisions of this Act are severable.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective
 upon enactment.
