PRIORITIZE CAPITAL DESIGNATE AND CERTAIN 22 **IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**, **PURCHASE** HEAVY EQUIPMENT NEEDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 10: M WORKS FOR FLOOD MITIGATION AND FUND THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND **TAXATION'S** 21 TRANSACTION PROCESSING SYSTEM.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent: I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Territorial Highway Fund (Guam Highway Fund) was recently audited and 3 that there are un-appropriated funds identified in the Balance Sheet that are 4 available for reprogramming for flood mitigation and projects 5 road repair/improvement projects throughout the island. There are specific areas in 6 Barrigada, Dededo, Ipan and Harmon that require immediate action. The projects 7 listed in Section 2 of this Act are areas that the Department of Public Works have 8 been made aware of their conditions and the work necessary to mitigate flooding 9 and other traffic safety related issues. I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the 10 acquisition of heavy equipment for drainage improvement and emergency flood 11 mitigation are necessary tools for the Department of Public Works to carry out its 12 mandates and responsibilities to ensure proper maintenance of our roadways. I 13 Liheslaturan Guåhan is also aware of the need to fund the Department of Revenue 14

and Taxation's Transaction Processing System as a means to upgrade and facilitate
certain functions within the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

Section 2. Appropriation from the Guam Highway Fund. 3 Notwithstanding any provision of law, the Sum of THREE MILLION NINE 4 HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,900,000) is hereby appropriated from 5 the un-appropriated fund balance of the Guam/Territorial Highway Fund to the 6 Department of Public Works and the Department of Revenue and Taxation as 7 follows: 8

Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Department of Public Works and 11 the Department of Administration shall submit a status report on all capital projects 12 initially authorized prior to this Act, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA and 13 §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, as well as the status of capital projects and other 14 purposes authorized pursuant to this Act, to I Maga'lahan Guåhan, and the 15 Speaker, I Liheslaturan Guåhan. 16

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to 17 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such 18 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be 19 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the 20 provisions of this Act are severable. 21

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective 22 upon enactment. 23
