BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1.** The Title of Chapter 37 of 9GCA is *amended* to read as follows: 3 4 "Chapter 37 5 **BURGLARY AND HOME INVASION"** 6 7 **Section 2.** A new Article 2 is added to Chapter 37 of 9GCA to read:

§37.201. Home Invasion. A person is guilty of home invasion when such person enters or remains unlawfully in a dwelling, while a person other than a participant in the crime is actually present in such dwelling, with intent to commit a crime therein, and, in the course of committing the offense: (1) Acting either alone or with one or more persons, such person or another participant in the crime commits or attempts to commit a felony against the person of another person other than a participant in the

- 1 crime who is actually present in such dwelling, or (2) such person is armed with
- 2 explosives or a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument.

- 4 §37.202. In the Course of Committing Home Invasion. An act shall be deemed "in
- 5 the course of committing" the offense if it occurs in an attempt to commit the offense
- 6 or flight after the attempt or commission.

- 8 §37.203. Knowledge of occupancy is not a defense. It is no defense the defendant
- 9 reasonably believed that the dwelling was unoccupied, by a person who was not a
- participant in the crime, at the time the home invasion occurred.

- 12 §37.204. Home Invasion Punished. (a) Home invasion is a first degree felony and
- 13 any person found guilty under this section shall be sentenced to a term of
- imprisonment of which at least ten (10) years may not be suspended or reduced by the
- 15 court.
- 16 (b) The sentence imposed for home invasion shall run consecutively to any sentence
- 17 for other crimes committed in conjunction with the home invasion.
