AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO \$21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE AGENCY'S TRANSACTION PROCESSING SYSTEM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 3 law, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) escheated to
- 4 the General Fund at the end of Fiscal Year 2012 and is available for
- 5 appropriations in Fiscal Year 2013, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21,
- 6 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the

- 1 Department of Revenue and Taxation for the purpose of funding the
- 2 agency's Transaction Processing System.
- 3 **Section 2. Unused Appropriation.** Funds not expended pursuant to
- 4 the provisions of this Act, within one (1) year following the date of
- 5 enactment, shall no longer be available to the Department of Revenue and
- 6 Taxation. Such funds shall become available for future appropriations by I
- 7 Liheslaturan Guåhan.
- 8 **Section 3. Reporting Requirement.** The Director of the Department
- 9 of Revenue and Taxation shall submit a report to I Maga'låhen Guåhan and I
- 10 Liheslaturan Guåhan, no later than One Hundred Eighty (180) days
- 11 following enactment of this Act, detailing all transactions pertaining to
- 12 funds appropriated herein.
- 13 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon
- 14 enactment.
