AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF NINE MILLION DOLLARS (\$9,000,000) FROM SECTION 30 TAX REVENUES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF TAX REFUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
- 2 finds that it is in the best interest of the Territory that funds from the advance
- 3 estimate of the 2014 Section 30 taxes owed to Guam by the Office of Insular
- 4 Affairs, United States Department of the Interior be used for the payment of
- 5 income tax refunds owed to the people.
- 6 Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of
- 7 Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000) is appropriated from the Section 30 tax

- 1 revenues to the Department of Administration. These funds shall be used to
- 2 pay for income tax refunds.
- 3 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application
- 4 to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
- 5 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which
- 6 can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this
- 7 end the provisions of this Law are severable.
