AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE MAYORS COUNCIL OF GUAM AND THE GUAM **ENVIRONMENTAL** (MCOG) PROTECTION AGENCY (GEPA) TO COLLABORATE ON DEVELOPMENT OF AN OPERATIONAL PLAN FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT, AND TO APPROPRIATE TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000)FROM THE **REVOLVING FUND TO** THE RECYCLING MAYORS COUNCIL OF GUAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT TO BE UTILIZED BY THE MCOG FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF RECYCLABLES, JUNK CARS, GREEN WASTE AND OTHER DEBRIS.

## **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds

that the Mayors and Vice-Mayors of Guam's 19 villages play pivotal
roles in our community in almost every area, including being
involved in providing, as much as possible, a clean and safe
environment for their constituents. Mayors and Vice-Mayors are also

7 a crucial factor in the removal of debris and the clearing of roads

8 following storms, disasters, and other events.

*I Liheslatura* intends that an appropriation from the Recycling Revolving Fund can maximize the effectiveness of Guam's Mayors and Vice Mayors in the collection and disposal of junk cars, green waste, recyclables and assorted debris, by providing sufficient equipment to achieve our community's goal of a cleaner and greener Guam.

Section 2. MCOG and GEPA to Prepare Plan. The Mayors 7 Council of Guam (MCOG) shall work with the Guam Environmental 8 9 Protection Agency (GEPA) to prepare an operational plan relative to 10 the implementation of this act, so that the MCOG can have access to needed heavy equipment required to clear roads, collect trash and 11 12 waste, remove junk cars and other debris on a regular basis, and 13 provide other village services, such equipment to be made available to each Mayor on a rotational basis. 14

15 Section 3. Proposed Operational Plan. The Mayors Council of 16 Guam (MCOG) and the GEPA Board of Directors *shall*, within one 17 hundred twenty (120) days of the date of enactment of this Act into 18 law, submit to *I Liheslaturan Guahan*, via a duly adopted resolution, a 19 proposed operational plan for the implementation of the provisions

1 of this Act.

Section 4. Appropriation. Upon approval and acceptance by I 2 3 Liheslatura of the proposed operational plan, Two Million Dollars 4 (\$2,000,000.00), is hereby appropriated from the Recycling Revolving 5 Fund for the procurement of heavy equipment for the MCOG to 6 include but not be limited to dump trucks, backhoes with trailers, 7 shredders, and flat beds for use by the various Mayors' offices for the 8 collection and disposal of recyclables, junk cars, green waste and 9 other debris. In accordance with the approved operational plan called 10 for in Section 3, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency shall 11 conduct the procurement of the heavy equipment funded by this Act.
