





1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Transfer to the Supplemental Appropriations Revenue
- 3 (SAR) Fund.
- 4 (a) The sum of One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 5 (\$1,700,000) from the surplus balance of the 2007 General Obligation Bonds

Series A *shall* be transferred to the Supplemental Appropriations Revenue (SAR) Fund upon the enactment of this Act.

(b) The sum of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) from the unappropriated, unallocated fund balance of the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) shall be transferred to the SAR Fund upon the enactment of this Act. The transfer in this Subsection (b) shall be considered an inter-fund borrowing and/or loan from the TAF to the SAR Fund and, notwithstanding the provisions in Chapters XIV and XV of Public Law 32-181, the amount of funds transferred from the TAF to the SAR Fund shall be repaid and/or transferred back to the TAF from the unexpended balance of the Classified Vacancies for Executive Branch Agencies and Departments Cost Pool Account and the Public Safety Vacancy Pool Cost Account to the Tourist Attraction Fund. The amount of funds transferred from the TAF to the SAR Fund shall be fully repaid and/or transferred back to the TAF from any sources derived within three (3) fiscal years from the date of transfer.

I Maga'lahen Guåhan and the Guam Visitors Bureau shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to establish a schedule of repayment to the Tourist Attraction Fund to restore Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) to the balance of the Fund within three (3) fiscal years of the passage of this Act.

Section 2. Guam Police Department Unpaid FY 2014 Overtime.

Eighty One Dollars (\$2,071,181) is hereby appropriated from the SAR Fund to the Guam Police Department for the sole purpose of paying unpaid overtime incurred by the Department in Fiscal Year 2014. Any funds not expended for the sole purpose herein *shall* remain in the SAR Fund. This appropriation *shall not* be subject to any transfer authority of *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.

(b) Section 1 of Public Law 32-168, as amended by Section 2 of Public Law 32-170, is hereby further *amended* to read:

"Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Four Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand One Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$439,181) is hereby appropriated from Fiscal Year 2014 General Fund revenues to the Guam Police Department for the purpose of paying prior years overtime incurred by the Department. The sum of Two Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$228,819) is hereby appropriated from Fiscal Year 2014 General Fund revenues to the Guam Police Department for the purpose of paying FY 2014 overtime incurred by the Department."

Section 3. Guam Police Department FY 2015 Overtime Prioritization and Appropriation.

- (a) A new Section 1(m)(5) is hereby *added* to Chapter V of Public Law 32-181 to read:
 - "(5) The sum of *not less than* One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) *shall* be allocated from the General Fund appropriation in Subsection (m)(1) to the Guam Police Department for the sole purpose of paying FY 2015 overtime incurred by the Department. The appropriation and allocation in this Subsection (5) *shall not* be subject to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan's* transfer authority."
- (\$1,500,000) is hereby appropriated from the SAR Fund to the Guam Police Department for the sole purpose of paying FY 2015 overtime incurred by the Department. The appropriation in this Section 3(b) *shall not* be subject to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan's* transfer authority.

- Section 4. Department of Corrections Unpaid Prior Years Overtime.
- 2 The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the SAR
- 3 Fund to the Department of Corrections for the sole purpose of paying unpaid

Section 9. The sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) is hereby appropriated from the SAR Fund to the Guam Economic Development Authority for the Guam Football Association for the development of gymnasium and classroom sports facilities in the northern part of the island.

Funding *shall only* be disbursed as a matching grant of private funds secured by the Guam Football Association pursuant to Chapter 77, Article 3, Title 12 GCA. The Guam Football Association *shall* submit to the Guam Economic Development Authority evidence of matching grant funds secured prior to certification of funds for disbursement, project plan(s), and subsequent invoices for project(s) funded by said appropriation.

Section 10. Guam Fire Department (GFD) Prior Year Outstanding GFD Overtime Obligations.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Guam Fire Department is hereby authorized to pay for prior year outstanding GFD overtime obligations incurred from its Fiscal Year 2015 appropriations.

Section 11. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* is hereby authorized to identify funding from any available resources up to the amount of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), for the Department of Agriculture to compensate farmers for crop damages from Typhoon *Halong*

- 1 (11W). Such sums identified are hereby appropriated to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose stated herein.
- 3 **Section 12. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
- 4 Section 13. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to


