AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §(e) TO §5123 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO MANDATING THE PURCHASE OR LEASE OF VEHICLES BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM SHALL MEET OR EXCEED A MINIMUM AVERAGE COMBINED CITY AND HIGHWAY MILES PER GALLON (MPG) OF TWENTY-FIVE MILES PER GALLON (25 MPG); TO ADD A NEW §(f) TO §5123 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO ALLOW CERTAIN SPECIALTY VEHICLES TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Statement.** It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to mandate
3 that the procurement of vehicles by the government of Guam includes a requirement of meeting or
4 exceeding a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard of Twenty-five
5 miles per gallon (25mpg), as determined by the United States Department of Energy's (USDOE)
6 rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website at www.fueleconomy.gov. It is also
7 recognized by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that there are vehicles required to perform various
8 governmental functions that are to be excluded from the mandate established by this Act.

9 **Section 2. A new §(e) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code**
10 **Annotated.** A new §(e) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

11 **“(e) Minimum Combined Miles Per Gallon Standard.** All vehicles to be purchased or
12 leased for use by the government of Guam shall meet or exceed a minimum average combined city
13 and highway miles per gallon of Twenty-five miles per gallon (25mpg), as determined by the United
14 States Department of Energy's (USDOE) rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website
15 at www.fueleconomy.gov.”

1 **Section 3.** A new §(f) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code
2 **Annotated.** A new §(f) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

3 **“(f) Excluded Vehicles.** The Chief Procurement Officer shall prepare and maintain a
4 listing of those vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway
5 miles per gallon standard. The type of vehicles that are to be excluded includes, but is not limited to:
6 law enforcement vehicles; vehicles whose primary function is to carry cargo; specialized utility
7 vehicles; construction vehicles; and any other vehicle whose primary function is other than the
8 transportation of five (5) passengers or fewer. For purposes of this Section, the Procurement Officers
9 for the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam Legislature, and any government of Guam entity *not* subject to
10 the Chief Procurement Officer’s procurement review, shall prepare and maintain a listing of those
11 vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon
12 standard as defined herein.“
