AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO §21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE AGENCY'S TRANSACTION PROCESSING SYSTEM.

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1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other provision of
3 law, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) escheated to
4 the General Fund at the end of Fiscal Year 2012 and is available for
5 appropriations in Fiscal Year 2013, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21,
6 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the

1 Department of Revenue and Taxation for the purpose of funding the
2 agency's Transaction Processing System.

3 **Section 2. Unused Appropriation.** Funds not expended pursuant to
4 the provisions of this Act, within one (1) year following the date of
5 enactment, shall no longer be available to the Department of Revenue and
6 Taxation. Such funds shall become available for future appropriations by *I*
7 *Lihselaturan Guåhan*.

8 **Section 3. Reporting Requirement.** The Director of the Department
9 of Revenue and Taxation shall submit a report to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* and *I*
10 *Lihselaturan Guåhan*, no later than One Hundred Eighty (180) days
11 following enactment of this Act, detailing all transactions pertaining to
12 funds appropriated herein.

13 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon
14 enactment.
