






**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF
THE REMAINING FIFTY PERCENT (50%)
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SALARY ADJUSTMENTS
PURSUANT TO THE COMPETITIVE WAGE ACT OF 2014.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the Section 30 Funds due to the Government of Guam, from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as a result of the EIN reconciliation performed by the IRS and the Department of Revenue and Taxation, to the Department of Administration for the payment of the remaining fifty percent (50%) salary adjustments as a result of the Competitive Wage Act of 2014. This appropriation shall apply retroactively to January 26, 2014 for those employees covered under the first fifty percent (50%) General Fund payment and to include the employees of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid, or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be

- 1 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
- 2 provisions of this Act are severable.
