**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1(j), CHAPTER V OF  
PUBLIC LAW 34-42, RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATING  
THE SUM OF UP TO THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,500,000) FROM THE GUAM  
HIGHWAY FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
WORKS FOR VILLAGE ROAD REPAIRS**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

3 *I Liheslatura* finds that in 2010 the Department of Public Works (DPW)  
4 adopted a Village Streets Master Plan (VSMP) which identified numerous village  
5 roads in need of repair and established a plan of implementation for the repairs.  
6 However, many village roads remain unrepaired and are still in dire need of repair.  
7 DPW has since updated the priority list of village roads that need repair by using the  
8 VSMP and input from the village mayors.

9 *I Liheslatura* finds that during a January 18, 2018 Oversight Hearing, DPW  
10 provided a Village Repair List dated December 14, 2017 (See Exhibit A attached)  
11 consisting of one prioritized road per village that is slated to be repaired and is  
12 estimated to cost Three Million Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Seventy-Five

1 Dollars (\$3,239,075). The funds that will be used for these repairs are from the sum  
2 of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000) from the Guam  
3 Highway Fund and Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) from the Guam Highway  
4 Fund Balance allocated in PL 34-42 and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the  
5 Governor’s Office which equals Four Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars  
6 (\$4,300,000). DPW also provided another Village Repair List dated August 24,  
7 2017 (See Exhibit B attached) that listed six roads per village which is estimated to  
8 cost Seventy-Four Million Seven Hundred Thirteen Thousand One Hundred  
9 Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$74,713,129). The roads listed on the December 14, 2017  
10 Village Repair List (Exhibit A) were included on the August 24, 2017 Village Repair  
11 List (Exhibit B.)

12 *I Liheslatura* finds that pursuant to Public Law 34-44 an additional estimated  
13 \$3.5 million will be collected in 2018. *I Liheslatura* further finds that Public Law  
14 34-44 did not include language that appropriates the additional tax revenues  
15 collected from the liquid fuel tax for the sole purposes of funding village road  
16 repairs. *I Liheslatura* intends that these additional Guam Highway funds are not  
17 diverted from village road repairs.

18 It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* that street repair be accomplished during 2018  
19 by the concerted effort of DPW employees and the efficient use of Guam Highway  
20 Funds.

21 **Section 2.** Section 1(j), Chapter V of Public Law 34-42 is hereby amended to  
22 read:

23 **“(j) DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW)**

24 **(1) Appropriation.** The sum of ~~Nineteen Million Three Hundred~~  
25 ~~Twelve Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (\$19,312,207)~~ Twenty-Two  
26 Million Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars  
27 (\$22,812,207) is appropriated to the Department of Public Works (DPW) for

its operations for Fiscal Year 2018. This sum is composed of ~~Ten Million Five Hundred Ninety six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty three Dollars (\$10,596,633)~~ Fourteen Million Ninety-Six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Three (\$14,096,633) from the Guam Highway Fund, Five Hundred Seventy-two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$572,468) from the Guam Highway Fund Balance, and Eight Million One Hundred Forty-three Thousand One Hundred Six Dollars (\$8,143,106) from the Territorial Educational Facilities Fund.

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(2) **Village Streets and Roads Resurfacing and Repairs.** The sum of One Million Eight Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$1,854,435) shall be allocated from the appropriation in Subsection (j)(1) for the purpose of funding village streets and roads resurfacing and repairs in Fiscal Year 2018.

(3) **Bus Operations.** Up to the sum of Eight Million One Hundred Forty-three Thousand One Hundred Six Dollars (\$8,143,106) shall be allocated from the Territorial Educational Facilities Fund appropriation in Subsection (j)(1) to fund bus operations in Fiscal Year 2018.

(4) **Comprehensive Cost-Benefit and Space Utilization Study.** The sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of

1 funding the Comprehensive Cost-Benefit and Space Utilization Study  
2 pursuant to Public Law 34-08.

3 **(5) Additional Village Streets and Roads Resurfacing and**  
4 **Repairs.** The sum of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars  
5 (\$3,500,000) shall be allocated in Fiscal Year 2018 from the appropriation in  
6 Subsection (j)(1) for the purpose of funding village streets and roads  
7 resurfacing and repairs as specified in Exhibit B. If DPW would like to re-  
8 prioritize or replace the village streets listed on the Village Repair List in  
9 Exhibit B, it must submit a new priority list of village street repairs to *I*  
10 *Lihselatura* for legislative approval or must certify that an emergency exists.”
