BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Short Title. This Act *shall* be cited as the “Working Families Relief Act.”

Section 2. To add a new § 26705 to Article 7 of Chapter 26, Title 11, GCA, as added by Public Law 34-87, to read:

“§ 26705. Exemptions. The sale of uncooked foods, pharmaceuticals, diapers, and feminine hygiene products shall be exempted from the General Sales Tax levied under § 26701 of this Chapter. For the purpose of this section, uncooked foods shall mean raw fruits, vegetables, eggs, fish, and meat; pharmaceuticals shall mean drugs as defined in 10 GCA § 40102, including prescription drugs and over-the-counter drugs; diapers shall include baby diapers and adult incontinence products; and feminine hygiene products shall include any product used by woman to manage menstrual hygiene.”

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
