**AN ACT TO AMEND § 73145 OF CHAPTER 73, TITLE 5 OF

QUARANTINE INSPECTION SERVICES CHARGE FOR
EACH PASSENGER TO TWENTY DOLLARS BEGINNING
OCTOBER 1, 2018.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 73145 of Chapter 73, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is
3 hereby amended to read:

4 **“§ 73145. Customs, Agriculture, and Quarantine Inspection Services**
5 **Charge Established.**

6 Each aircraft landing at the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport, Guam
7 shall be levied a Customs, Agriculture and Quarantine Inspection services charge
8 reasonably related to the costs incurred by the Customs and Quarantine Agency and
9 the Department of Agriculture in providing, maintaining and operating the service
10 charge facilities, and shall be allocated among air carriers in such a manner reasonably
11 related to the relative demand for such services attributable to each carrier. Each
12 consignment of air and sea cargo, and each passenger landing at a sea port shall also
13 be levied a Customs, Agriculture and Quarantine Inspection services charge, except
14 for those passengers which may be exempted under the rules and regulations
15 promulgated pursuant to § 73151.

16 The service charges shall be reasonably related to the costs incurred by the

1 Customs and Quarantine Agency and the Department of Agriculture in providing,
2 maintaining and operating the service charge facilities.

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the establishment, modification or
4 adjustment of any service charge levied pursuant to this Section shall be subject to the
5 provisions of the Administrative Adjudication Law until October 1, 2018, at which
6 point the Customs, Agriculture and Quarantine Inspection services charge for each
7 passenger shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The establishment, modification or
8 adjustment of all other service charges levied pursuant to this Section shall remain
9 subject to the Administrative Adjudication Law.”
