AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU FOR THE HURÂO ACADEMY CHAMORU LANGUAGE "IMMERSION" PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the CHamoru language is at risk of extinction. The number of CHamoru speakers continues to decline with the average number of "proficient" CHamoru speakers being over the age of fifty-five (55) years old. The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization's (UNESCO) classifies a language as being serverly endangered when the language is spoken by grandparents and older generations and when the parent generation may understand it, but they do not speak it to children or among themselves. Furthermore, a language is critically endangered when grandparents speak the language partially and infrequently. These trends are seen in our society among the CHamoru people on Guam. The CHamoru language can be considered severely or critically endangered and may become extinct by the year 2025.

Established in 2005, *Huråo* Academy is the first "full-immersion" *CHamoru* language program to meet the needs of a community struggling to preserve its language by continuing its mission "to promote and perpetuate the *CHamoru* language and culture in honor of the past, for present and future generations, through

1 community immersion education and other programs in support of this mission."

2 The Huråo Academy has served over four thousand (4000) students in its short

3 history, and has a wait list of parents wanting their children to participate in this

program. The Huråo Academy sees that in order to provide an effective language

program, consistent exposure to and practice of the CHamoru language should be

6 integrated in every subject in class starting at the preschool level.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that language immersion methodologies have proven to be successful for language restoration in a number of communities around the world. One (1) model is the Aha Punana Leo Pre-School in Hawaii, which surrounds pre-school age children in an environment conducive to learning their native language. The Huråo, Inc., dba Huråo Academy, is building on the Aha Punana Leo Pre-School's model to teach the CHamoru language to the next generation of CHamoru speakers.

I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that in 2017 seed funding was provided to the Huråo Academy for the Nene Academy pilot. The concept was proven to be successful with 41 applicants in the Nene Academy's inagural year. Unfortunately, many applicants had to be turned away due to their limited capacity. Hiring and training educators skilled in immersion techniques and deveoping a chamorro immersion curriculum was a challenge for the Nene Academy. However, due to interest in the Nene Academy from the public, the Academy is seeking to expand services to keep up with demand.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the increase in fluency of the CHamoru language creates a greater awareness of the CHamoru culture. This will further develop and enhance our tourism industry, filling a growing trend in a type of traveler called the "experential traveler" who visits destinations to experience the unique culture of the native people. The most valuable and unique tourism asset our island has, separating us from other similar destination, is our CHamoru culture.

1	Developing our cultural resources goes hand in hand with developing our tourism
2	industry.
3	It is, therefore, the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to support the Huråd
4	Academy's development of a CHamoru language "immersion" pre-school program
5	Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, for Fiscal
6	Year 2019, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) shall be
7	appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to Guam Visitors Bureau for the
8	Huråo Academy and the Huråo Academy's CHamoru language "immersion" pre-
9	school program.
10	Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions contained herein shall be effective
11	upon enactment of this Act.
