AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 8104(p) OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO INCLUDING DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS PAROLE OFFICERS AS UNIFORMED PERSONNEL FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that Guam's law enforcement uniformed personnel may retire from the government of Guam five (5) years earlier than other government employees.

It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to include Department of Corrections Parole Officers as a beneficiary of the early retirement statute, making whole their membership of the uniformed personnel of the government of Guam.

Section 2. § 8104(p) of Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

“(p) Uniformed Personnel means Guam Police Department Officers; Guam Fire Department Firemen; Customs and Quarantine Officers of the Customs and Quarantine Agency; Conservation Officers, Commodity Inspectors, and Entomologists of the Department of Agriculture; Territorial Park Patrol Officers of the Department of Parks and Recreation; Corrections Officers and Parole Officers of the Department of Corrections; Airport Police Officers and Security Personnel at the Antonio B. Won Pat International

1 Airport Authority, Guam; Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Security
2 Personnel; Marshals of the Supreme Court of Guam and the Superior Court
3 of Guam; Probation Officers of the Judiciary of Guam; Firefighters of the
4 Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam; and Youth
5 Service Workers of the Department of Youth Affairs engaged in juvenile
6 detention and rehabilitation. In all matters involving the uniformed personnel
7 at the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam, the Jose D.
8 Leon Guerrero Commercial Port, or the Department of Parks and Recreation,
9 the Supreme Court of Guam and the Superior Court of Guam Marshals, and
10 the Guam Police Department shall have concurrent jurisdiction with such
11 personnel.”

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
