**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 1102.04 TO CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 4, TITLE 2, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, RELATIVE TO INCENTIVIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF ZERO EMISSIONS VEHICLES BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 1102.04 is hereby *added* to Chapter 1, Division 4,  
3 Title 2, of Title 5, Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations, to read:

4 **“§ 1102.04 Zero Emissions Vehicle Preference.**

5 The Chief Procurement Officer, the Director of Public Works,  
6 or the head of the Purchasing Agency shall, whenever practicable,  
7 procure zero-emissions vehicles. The cost (prior to any adjustments  
8 for local vendors) of a zero-emissions vehicle may be as much as ten  
9 percent (10%) greater than the cost of similarly performing vehicle  
10 with an internal combustion engine.

11 The Chief Procurement Officer, the Director of Public Works,  
12 or the head of a Purchasing Agency shall determine the authenticity of  
13 any statement that a vehicle is zero-emissions, and whether such

1           vehicle meets the performance needs of the government of Guam. If  
2           the bidder qualifies for the ten percent (10%) preference under this  
3           section, then the bidder must be given this preference.”

4           **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to  
5 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
6 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be  
7 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
8 provisions of this Act are severable.
