BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. 4302 (c) (9) of Article 3, Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

“(9) The Negotiating Team upon selection and review of the ~~best available~~ two most beneficial proposals by participating healthcare respondents/providers which reflect the most economical and beneficial healthcare insurance proposal plan for government of Guam employees and retirees, and foster children, shall forward the ~~accepted proposals~~ two most beneficial proposals to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* or *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* for consideration, and to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for final approval no later than July 31, and prior to the annual legislative sessions wherein the upcoming fiscal year budget for the government of Guam is before *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for consideration.”

1 (A) Most beneficial is defined as a plan that provides a broad and
2 comprehensive network of medical providers both on-island and off-island,
3 has met the required minimum benefits, offers reasonable and sustainable
4 rates, and has demonstrated consistent high level of member satisfaction
5 through measurable surveys.

6 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act Shall become effective upon
7 enactment.

8 **Section 3. Severability:** If any provision of this Act or its application to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other
10 provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid
11 provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
