AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT) SURPLUS FUND TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that there exists Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) in the
- 4 Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund available for appropriation.
- 5 Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the
- 6 sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) is hereby appropriated from
- 7 the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitors

- 1 Bureau for the improvement, refurbishment, restoration, repair, and/or
- 2 maintenance of one (1) park or attraction per village, including village murals.
- 3 Notwithstanding the general provisions of § 30107.1 of Chapter 30, Title 11, Guam
- 4 Code Annotated, this appropriation shall continue to be available until expended
- 5 and is *not* subject to transfer or use for any other purpose.
