AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 77302 OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 77, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE DUTIES OF THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY ASSISTED POLICING EFFORT (CAPE) VOLUNTEERS TO INCLUDE THE 12TH FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS (FESTPAC).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 77302 of Title 10, Guarn Code Annotated, is hereby *amended*to read as follows:

4 "§ 77302. Volunteers. Pursuant to § 3401.1(h) of Article 4,
5 Chapter 3 of Title 16 Guam Code Annotated, the Chief of Police is
6 authorized to recruit volunteers to assist the Guam Police Department in the

enforcement of the accessible parking and littering laws. In addition to these
duties, the Chief of Police shall authorize the use of volunteers to patrol the
school campuses of the Guam Department of Education during non-school
hours. The volunteers shall take no enforcement action during their patrol of
the school campuses, and shall notify the police of suspicious activity or
crimes in progress. The Superintendent of Education shall cooperate with the
Chief of Police to implement this Section.

8 The Chief of Police is further authorized to recruit volunteers to assist 9 the Guam Police Department with traffic direction, security, and crowd 10 control for events such as, but not limited to, the Guam Ko'ko Road Race, the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair, the Liberation Day Parade, and the 12th 11 Festival of Pacific Arts (FestPac), in which the specific tasks will be 12 coordinated with the 12thFestPac Security Committee. Volunteers may only 13 assist the Guam Police Department if they have previously obtained a 14 15 certificate from the Chief of Police demonstrating the successful completion of a required course of instruction and training that includes training relative 16 17 to traffic direction, security, and crowd control."
