AN ACT TO TRANSFER A PORTION OF LOT NO. 5075-REM-A NEW-1, MUNICIPALITY OF *TAMUNING*, WITH AN AREA OF FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX (5,686) SQUARE METERS, FROM THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION LANDS INVENTORY TO THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW DETENTION BASIN AND WATER STORAGE TANKS; AND TO REZONE LOT NO. 5075-REM-A NEW-1 FROM COMMERCIAL ZONE (C) TO A PUBLIC FACILITY ZONE (PF).

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds

3 that the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) has identified property, owned by the

Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC), for the purpose of constructing a new detention basin which will allow for the replacement of the existing one (1) million gallon (1MG) water storage and for the construction of an above ground two (2) million gallon (2MG) water storage reservoir. These improvements are essential in meeting current and future growth demands for drinking water and improve operational reliability of the water system.

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I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the construction of a new 2MG reservoir at the selected site will increase total storage capacity from 1MG to 3MG. The increased storage capacity will address growth in water demand due to population growth and improve operational reliability. More specifically, the new reservoir will also enhance service to the *Tamuning*, *Tumon* and *Hagåtña* service zones, as well as to the water system overall.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that GWA and CLTC have been working cooperatively to address the critical property needs to meet the 2011 court order deadlines, and the CLTC has approved a Board resolution to support the GWA system improvement plans.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that this project is necessary and will benefit the people of Guam. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to authorize the CLTC to transfer five thousand six hundred eighty-six (5,686) square meters (1.40 acres), more or less, to the GWA to accomplish the necessary improvements described above. GWA and CLTC have agreed on the basic terms of the transfer to meet the needs and mandates of both parties, and have committed to finalize compensation to the CLTC within one hundred eighty (180) days of the enactment of this Act.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that GWA, under United States
 Department of Justice ORDER FOR PRELIMINARY RELIEF RE: DEADLINES
 FOR OUTSTANDING PROJECTS UNDER THE AMENDED STIPULATED
 ORDER Civil Case No. 02-00035 (Court Order or CO) effective as of 11/10/2011,

1 is required to "assess and repair, rehabilitate, replace and/or relocate all Guam 2 Waterworks Authority water reservoirs within its systems as detailed in § II (C) $\P 29$ 3 (b) of the order, and the deadline to complete these tasks specified for the water 4 reservoirs is 2018."

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5 Section 2. Authorization to Transfer Land Identified to the Guam Waterworks Authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or 6 7 regulation, I Liheslaturan Guåhan authorizes the Chamorro Land Trust Commission 8 to transfer a portion of Lot No. 5075-REM-A NEW-1, municipality of Tamuning, 9 with an area of approximately five thousand six hundred eighty-six (5,686) square 10 meters (1.40 acres), more or less, as shown on proposed Parceling Survey Map L.M. 11 No. 057FY2016 (see Exhibit A), prepared by Guam Surveyor, LLC, Dennis 12 Balagtas, P.L.S. #75, from the lands inventory of the Chamorro Land Trust 13 Commission to the Guam Waterworks Authority to construct a new detention basin which will allow for the replacement of the existing one (1) million gallons water 14 15 storage and for the construction of an above ground two (2) million gallons water 16 storage reservoir. The administrative transfer of property shall become effective 17 upon the enactment of this Act.

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Guam Waterworks Authority shall pay for the appraisal of the (a) property by two (2) different appraisers, one (1) which shall be selected by the Director of the CLTC.

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(b)Guam Waterworks Authority *shall* have the property surveyed at 22 its own expense, and the surveyed map *shall* be approved and recorded by the 23 Department of Land Management.

24 Guam Waterworks Authority shall work with Chamorro Land (c)25 Trust Commission to determine an appropriate compensation for the property, 26 to include, but not be limited to, a land exchange, purchase, or a combination 27 of options to be approved by Guam Waterworks Authority, the Consolidated

Commission on Utilities (CCU) and Chamorro Land Trust Commission.
 GWA and CLTC shall have one hundred eighty (180) days to finalize a
 compensation agreement.

*

4 (d) Chamorro Land Trust Commission immediately grants right of 5 entry for GWA to complete the required geotechnical survey, topographic 6 survey, archeological studies, and other required testing and studies to initiate 7 the design for the construction of the detention basin and construction of new 8 water reservoirs while both parties are finalizing compensation and the deed 9 is recorded.

Section 3. Zoning Designation. Lot No. 5075-REM-A NEW-1,
municipality of *Tamuning*, *shall* be rezoned from a Commercial Zone (C) to a Public
Facility Zone (PF) pursuant to 21 GCA, Chapter 61, § 61313.

- 13 Section 4. Reversionary Clause Upon Inaction. The Guam Waterworks 14 Authority *shall* begin construction of the detention basin and new water reservoirs 15 within five (5) years from the date of the enactment of this Act. In the event, the 16 Guam Waterworks Authority does not begin construction of the detention basin 17 within the stipulated period, without notice to the Chamorro Land Trust 18 Commission, or defaults on the compensation agreement, the property *shall* revert 19 to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission.
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Section 5. Effective Date. This Act *shall* take effect upon its enactment.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law, which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications and to this end the provisions of this law are severable.



GUAM CONSOLIDATED COMMISSION ON UTILITIES RESOLUTION NO. 29-FY2016

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RELATIVE TO APPROVING PROPOSED LEGISLATION FOR ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION PROPERTIES

WHEREAS, under 12 G.C.A. § 14105, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities ("CCU") has plenary authority over financial, contractual and policy matters relative to the Guam Waterworks Authority ("GWA"); and

WHEREAS, the Guam Waterworks Authority ("GWA") is a Guam Public Corporation 11 established and existing under the laws of Guani; and 12

14 WHEREAS, the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) has identified property, owned by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC), for the purpose of rebuilding the existing 1.6 water reservoir, constructing a stormwater detention basin to address United States 18 Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Clean Water Act (CWA) requirements and to 15 construct future additional reservoirs which will assist in meeting current and future growth 26 21 demands for drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) has been working with the staff 24 of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) to address the critical property needs to meet the 2011 Court Order deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, having agreed that GWA's request tor additional land for required infrastructure development projects is in the public's interest and is an immediate necessity, approved resolutions to support GWA's request (Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission has also approved the Right of Entry as an interim measure to allow GWA to access the properties to conduct required studies, surveys and necessary actions to begin the design of the required requirement for the water reservoirs (Attachment B); and

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ÿ WHEREAS, GWA and CLTC have developed draft legislation to acquire the properties 10 to meet the needs of GWA. Upon passage of the law, GWA and CLTC will develop a 11 reasonable compensation package for the acquired properties. Due to the time constraints 12 1.2 imposed by the Court Order to complete the project, GWA and CLTC have agreed on the basic 14 terms of the transfer to meet the needs and mandates of both parties, and have committed to 15 finalize the terms of compensation to the Chamorro Land Trust within one hundred eighty (180) 16 17 days of the enactment of the proposed legislation

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities does hereby approve and authorize the following:

23 Section 1. The foregoing recitals hereto are hereby ratified, confirmed, and 24 incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Consolidated Commission on Utilities approves the following attached
 draft bills:

a) AN ACT TO TRANSFER A PORTION OF LOT NO. 5075-REM-A NEW-1, MUNICIPALITY OF TAMUNING WITH AN AREA OF 5.686± SQUARE METERS FROM THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INVENTORY AND TO THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE EXISTING WATER RESERVIOR (TANK) AND CONSTRUCTING AN ADDITIONAL

WATER RESERVIOR TO COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY 2011 COURT ORDER. (Attachment C)

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b) AN ACT TO TRANSFER A PORTION OF LOT NO. 470-R3, MUNICIPALITY OF SANTA RITA WITH AN AREA OF 2855± SQUARE METERS FROM THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INVENTORY TO THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A STORM WATER RETENTION BASIN AND RECONSTRUCTING A WATER RESERVOIR TO COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY 2011 COURT ORDER. c) AN ACT TO TRANSFER A PORTION OF LOT NO. 10164-1, MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO WITH AN AREA OF 1852± SQUARE METERS FROM THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INVENTORY AND TO THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A FUTURE WATER RESERVIOR (TANK) AND RELOCATING A PUMP STATION AS PART OF THE COMPLIANCE ACTIONS REQUIRED TO MEET THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY 2011 COURT ORDER. 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CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-02**

Declaration and Designation of Land for Guam Waterworks Authority Infrastructure Development

WHEREAS, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (hereafter CLTC), in accordance with Title 21, Section 75105, declares the need to make land available for Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) infrastructure development;

WHEREAS, the CLTC board of commissioners recognizes GWA's need for additional land for infrastructure development is in the public interest and an immediate necessity;

WHEREAS, the CLTC board of commissioners recognize and acknowledge GWA's immediate need to prepare the desired land authorize the execution of a "Grant of Right-Of-Way" until law is enacted to assign the property to GWA;

WHEREAS, the CLTC board of commissioners require the land assignment be compensated at a rate and/or process to be determined at a later date to be set in the law assigning the property to GWA;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2016, the CLTC board of commissioners at their regularly scheduled meeting, Tamuning, Guam, reviewed and approved by a motion to designate as available the proposed land as necessary for the public good to be assigned to the Guam Waterworks Authority by legislative action:

Proposed Lot 5075-REM-A NEW 1, Municipality of Tamuning, consisting of 5,686+ square meters, as shown on the proposed Parceling Survey Map, L.M. No. 057FY2016, prepared by Guam Surveyor, LLC, Dennis S. Balagtas, P.L.S. #75, shown in Exhibit "A", currently zoned Residential Multi-Family Dwelling (R2).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. The Chamorro Land Trust Commission Board of Commissioners approves the listed land and declares this land to be available and designated property for the Guarn Waterworks Authority infrastructure development who will be fully responsible for any and all land surveys and land registration, as necessary;
- 2. The Chamorro Land Trust Commission authorizes the execution of a "Right of Entry Agreement" for the designated property identified above to the Guam Waterworks Authority; and
- 3. The Chamorro Land Trust Commission Board of Commissioners transmits this Resolution to 1 Liheslaturan Guahan with its recommendation to include the designated property in legislation to assign it to the Guam Waterworks Authority with compensation to be determined within a specified period listed in the enacted law.
