AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 3101.4 TO ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; AND TO AMEND § 57100 OF CHAPTER 57, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT OF A DISTINGUISHING MARK FOR GUAM VETERANS ON GUAM DRIVER'S LICENSES AND GUAM IDENTIFICATION CARDS; AND TO REQUIRE THAT QUARTERLY REPORTS BE TRANSMITTED TO I MAGA'LÅHEN GUÅHAN AND THE SPEAKER OF I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN OF THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1	<b>Section 1.</b> A new § 3101.4 is hereby <i>added</i> to Article 1 of Chapter 3, Title
2	16, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
3	"§ 3101.4. Veterans Designation for Driver's Licenses,
4	Identification Cards, and Renewals of Same. Every applicant for a Guam
5	driver's license or a Guam identification card who is a veteran, pursuant to §
6	7120.2(b) of Chapter 7 of this Title, shall, at the applicant's request, have the
7	word 'Veteran' affixed on a section of the Guam driver's license or the Guam
8	identification card. The requirements of this Section shall also apply to the
9	renewal of the same."
10	Section 2. § 57100 of Chapter 57, Division 3, Title 10, Guam Code
11	Annotated, is hereby amended to read:
12	"§ 57100. Certificate of Identification: Requirement and Fee.
13	Any person may obtain a certificate of identification from the
14	Department of Revenue and Taxation. The Director of Revenue and Taxation
15	is authorized to issue such certificate of identification without charge in a form
16	prescribed by him.
17	Every applicant for a certificate of identification from the Department
18	of Revenue and Taxation who is a veteran, pursuant to § 7120.2(b) of Chapter
19	7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, shall, at the applicant's request, have the
20	word 'Veteran' affixed on a section of the certificate of identification. The
21	requirements of this Section shall also apply to the renewal of the same."
22	Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Director of the Department of
23	Revenue and Taxation shall, on the fifteenth (15th) day after the close of every fiscal
24	quarter, transmit to I Maga'låhen Guåhan and the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan,
25	a report identifying the total number of veterans who possess a Guam driver's license

or a certificate of identification from the Department. The report shall include the

- 1 number of veterans in each village, and the total number of veterans by gender, age,
- 2 and branch of service.
- 3 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective on October 1, 2016.
