

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (d) OF § 5204 OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF SPORTS EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR YOUTH AND COMMUNITY SPORTS PROGRAMS.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.** Subsection (d) of § 5204 of Article 2 of Chapter 5, Title 11,  
3        Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

1           “(d) Moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated  
2 reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, *shall* be appropriated in the  
3 following manner in each fiscal year:

4           (1) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
5 Mayors Council of Guam for the repair and construction of village  
6 recreational facilities, including community centers, and for the  
7 procurement of sports equipment and supplies, including, but *not*  
8 limited to, team sponsorships and uniforms. Funds may also be used  
9 to purchase equipment required to support community programs  
10 administered by village mayors;

11           (2) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
12 Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair and construction of  
13 its facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and  
14 supplies; and

15           (3) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
16 Department of Education for the repair and construction of its sports  
17 facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies.

18           (4) *Not more than* fifty percent (50%) of the amount  
19 authorized in Item (1), twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized  
20 in Item (2), and twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in  
21 Item (3), respectively, of this Subsection for the repair and  
22 construction of village recreational facilities and for the procurement  
23 of sports equipment and supplies *shall* be used for the procurement of  
24 sports equipment and supplies, including but not limited to, team  
25 sponsorships and uniforms.”
