AN ACT TO AMEND § 1515(i)(2)(G) OF ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FROM JULY 31, 2015 TO MARCH 31, 2016, FOR THE GUAM FISHERMEN'S COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION TO EXPEND OR ENCUMBER THE PROCEEDS OF THE GRANT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE GUAM FISHERMEN'S COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION FACILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 1515(i)(2)(G) of Article 5, Chapter 2 of Title 5, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(G) for purposes of issuing a grant of no more than Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to the Guam Fishermen's Cooperative Association (GFCA) for the purposes of construction, repair and improvements of its facility as part of the Greg D. Perez Marina Economic Enhancement Master Plan.

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No funds authorized in this Section shall be used to pay the Guam Economic Development Authority or its contracted consultants.

Notwithstanding the order of priority requirement in § 1515(i)(2) and upon enactment, the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) of the proceeds are authorized, appropriated and shall be deposited and accounted for in a separate trustee sub-account for the payments of expenses associated with the construction, repair and improvements of the GFCA facility. Any services or contracts or expenses associated with the construction, repair and improvements of the GFCA facility under this grant shall require the approval of the GFCA. Disbursements for payments of expenses associated with the construction, repair and improvements of the GFCA facility shall be approved by the GFCA and countersigned by GEDA. The proceeds of the grant must be expended or encumbered by the GFCA for the purposes provided herein no later than March 31, 2016. If any funds authorized by this Section remain unexpended or unencumbered after March 31, 2016, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be subject to legislative re-appropriation. Funds not authorized for expenditure by the GFCA in this Section are subject to legislative appropriation for tourismrelated capital improvement projects. The GFCA shall report to I Maga'lahi (the Governor) and the Speaker of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) on a quarterly basis of all expenditures of this grant and other funds secured by the GFCA used for the construction, repair and improvements of its facility
